Work-In-Process

When we think of being physically fit, we typically grasp the concept that healthiness is the sum total of various systems in our body working together properly. When we consider our children's academic progress, we understand that there are various areas of the brain motor system that must be stimulated and developed over time. Yet, when it comes to social and spiritual growth, we sometimes panic when our children are not acting like angles overnight.

Children must have an opportunity to learn biblical principles and play them out in everyday situations with their peers. At times, kids will make the right choices, and other times they will not make the best decisions. However, conflict provides an excellent opportunity to nurture the heart.

Even the most ambitious adult would think it unrealistic for an infant to learn trigonometry because there are foundational math skills that would be necessary prior to teaching higher-level concepts. The same holds true for social and spiritual development. Children will not comprehend all of the aspects of spiritual maturity in one setting. Instead, they must be challenged to live out what they learn, and have room to make mistakes as they grow and mature through experiences.

In chapel this year, we are focusing on Biblical examples of individuals who had a heart after God. A passion for the Lord is important as we desire to reflect His nature and make Him the priority in our lives. God is patient with us as we grow in our relationship with Him. Therefore, let us extend grace to our children as they grow in their relationship with Christ; it is a work in process.
