Afternoon Carpool/Pickup Procedures

Want simple tips to make afternoon pickup smoother?

1. Clearly communicate your carpool desires to Cambridge.
2. Plan on arriving promptly between 3:20 – 3:30 PM.
3. Remain in your vehicle in the carpool line on 47th Street.
4. Allow teachers to conclude the day.
5. Allow students to be dismissed from school.
6. Drive carefully out of the carpool line.
7. If you need to leave your vehicle, park your car on 47th Street.

Today, teachers will inventory your child's school supplies. If your child is not equipped for school with the necessary supplies, a mark will appear in the homework folder in the coming days stating that this needs to be accomplished. Help your child have a great start to school!

Health Forms are Required!

If you have not submitted your medical forms to the school by Friday, September 9th, your child will not be admitted to class on Monday, September 12th. By state law, we must have your child's medical forms completed and on file. If you have an appointment that is scheduled for after the start of school, it is imperative that you contact the school office. We also require a new family emergency form to be completed, even if you think the information has not changed since last year. We have to know how to contact you in the event of an emergency.

Parents' Corner

The accumulation of new knowledge most often begins with a question. Children ask many questions as they seek to discover new information. Parents who both encourage and answer questions improve a child's ability to reason and investigate. Conversely, parents who repress a child's questions may lose or undervalue the golden opportunity to teach.

What is the Homework Folder?

This week, your child will come home with a red, gold, or black homework folder or 3-ring binder (Grammar Class III-Dialectic Class II). The purpose of the homework folder is to provide you with daily information, such as teacher messages, school announcements, and other communication. In addition, you will find one place where your child's homework is located. Daily discipline and reading accountability is also located in this folder.

Your responsibility is to sign and/or initial the sheets in the folder *after* your child has completed his homework. His teacher will check for your signature on a daily basis. Each child also has a daily reading assignment. Please participate by following the guidelines listed.
