Move



Movement represents progress to most individuals. We often desire to obtain personal goals such as career advancement, financial increase, and academic achievement. We work long hours, make sacrifices, and pour ourselves into our own ambitions.

Do we have spiritual aspirations on our radar as well? Are we willing to passionately pursue a closer walk with God? Do we want to hear his soft still voice speak to our hearts? Are we willing to “move” out of our comfort zone to receive something extraordinary from the Lord?

Fasting is a biblical discipline which allows us to deny our flesh in order to feed our spirit. Fasting includes restraints of our natural pleasures and/or strengths with the purpose of positioning ourselves to receive freely from the Holy Spirit. Some of the rewards are *external*, as our circumstances are touched by God's power. Some of our rewards are *internal*, as our hearts encounter Him. We fast both to walk in more of God's power to change the world, and to encounter more of His heart to change our heart!

In Isaiah 58, fasting is to (1) loosen the bonds of wickedness; (2) undo heavy burdens; (3) help the oppressed go free; (5) give bread to the hungry; (6) receive the light of revelation in God's Word; (7) for emotional and physical health; and (8) that righteousness would break forth.

Cambridge, I encourage you to participate in the voluntary fast scheduled for January 11th-13th. The adults that partake in the three day fast should eat only fruits, vegetables, whole grains and refrain from watching television. Students that desire to participate should only refrain from television and electronic games. Let's start the New Year by feasting on the person of Jesus. We will be amazed by His power to “MOVE” upon our circumstances and hearts.
